➤ LANGUAGE**Unit 1 Getting to know you**

- Asking questions: intonation in Yes/No and WH-questions, *Who's vs Whose?*
- *"A blind date"*: reading about how couples first met; filling in a personal form.
- Adjectives -ed/-ing; adjectives and nouns that go together (*delicious + meal*); words with 2 meanings (*date, left, ...*), phrases with a preposition (*crazy about, interested in, ...*)
- Present Simple and Continuous, Past Simple

Unit 2 Let's get together

- *Have vs have got*, state verbs (*love, need, own, ...*);
- My perfect day: likes & dislikes (*enjoy, love, be fond of, keen on, can't stand, dislike*);
- Making conversation: showing interest, adding comments, etc.
- Linkers for contrast, cause and result: *but, although, however, so, because*

Unit 3 Good news, bad news!

- Narrative tense: Past Simple and Past Continuous
- Reading, telling and writing a story based on good news
- Making up stories from headlines
- Irregular verbs p.158
- Past Simple: pronunciation of *-ed*
- Adverbs (*carefully, noisily, well, ...*)
- Saying dates

Unit 4 Food for thought

- Quantifiers: *some/any; a lot of/a little, a few; much/many, little/few*;
- Countable and uncountable nouns (*food and drinks*)
- Uncountables: *advice, furniture, information, news, ...*
- Articles: *a/an/the*
- Shops and phrases like *"a loaf of bread, a packet of tissues, ..."*
- Making and responding to polite requests: *Could I/Could you possibly/Would you like/mind ... ?*

Unit 5 The future's in your hands

- Verb patterns: *I want to/I'd like to/I'm looking forward to...*
- Hopes and plans: going to, will, Present Continuous for future

Unit 6 History repeats itself

- Present Perfect with *since and for*;
- **PROJECT** on scientists who made important inventions or discovered lifesavers like penicillin and contributed to the enhancement of society in different fields (IPPOCRATE)
- Finding out information about famous scientists like Oppenheimer, A. Volta, C. Golgi, R. Levi Montalcini, etc.

- Organising information into a text + delivering an oral presentation.

- Presenting your park orally


Pentamestre 2024 (6 ore)


